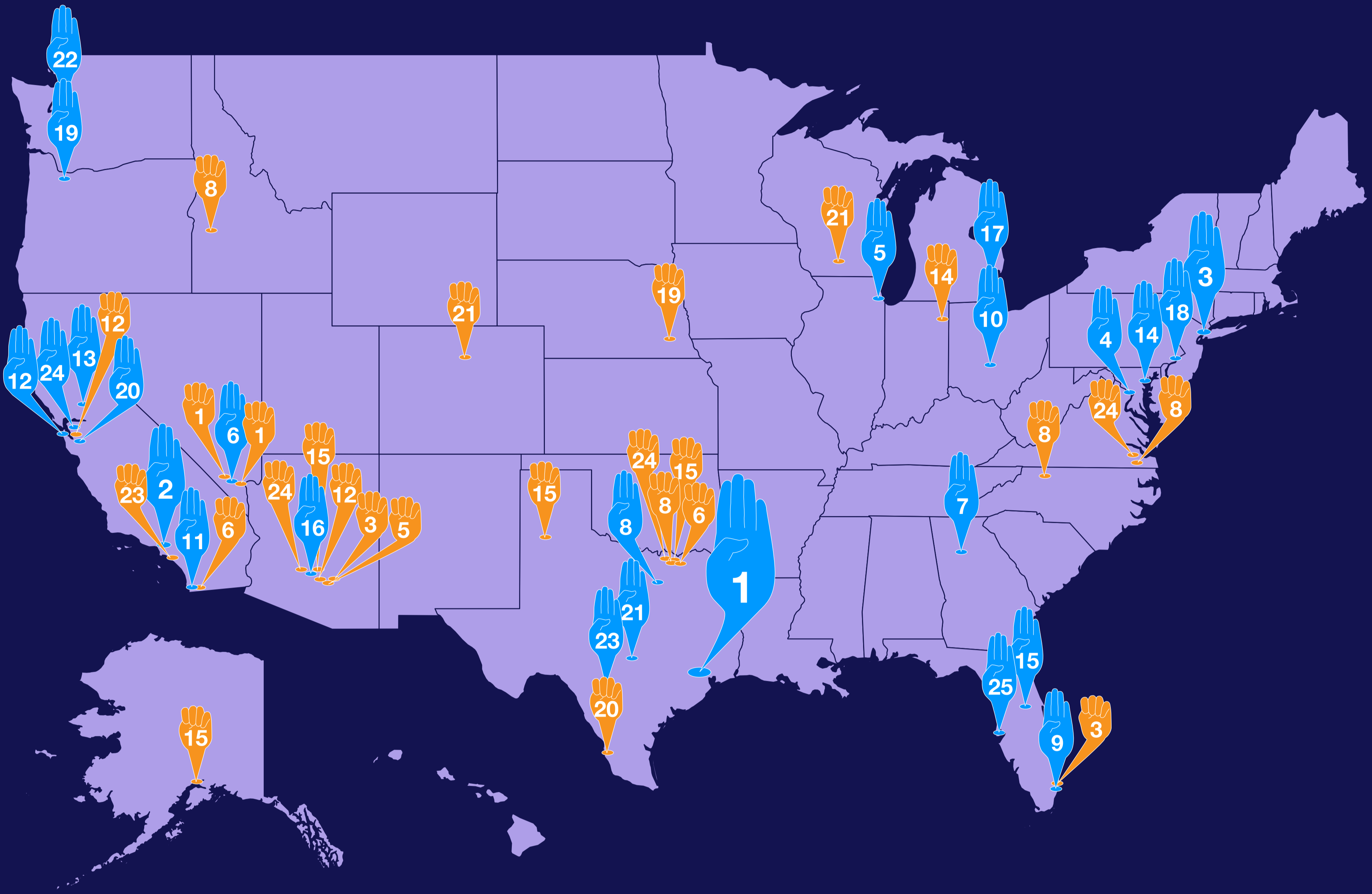
# CASES OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING

The 100 most populous cities in the U.S. were ranked on the number of cases created by the National Human Trafficking Hotline between December 7, 2007 and December 31, 2016; we highlighted the 25 cities with the most, and the fewest, number of cases. A case is a unique report, situation, or request for resources that originated as a signal to the hotline. Each case included in the report was evaluated for evidence of potential human trafficking and was determined to have either high or moderate indicators of human trafficking.
